

SUBJECT: NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP

STUDENTS: Your cumulative high school grade point average qualifies you to be considered as a candidate for membership in the Central Lyon Chapter of the National Honor Society if you so desire.

Each student who wishes to be considered for selection must fill out the attached Student Activity Information Form. This form is not an application, but it gives the NHS Faculty Council important information. Please fill out this form carefully and return it to Mrs. Bloemendaal no later than **Tuesday, October 4, 2016 AT 3:30 P.M.** **Students who fail to turn in these forms on time indicate a lack of interest on their part and will therefore NOT be considered for membership.** If you can't get an advisor signature in Part IV, please clearly print the name in that space instead. **Please also notice that a parental signature is required on your information form.**

The high school faculty will be asked to evaluate those students who wish to be considered with respect to: (1) character, (2) service, and (3) leadership. Faculty input, along with completed student activity information forms, will be used by the NHS Faculty Council to help determine their selection of members to the National Honor Society. A majority vote of the faculty council is necessary for membership selection.

No student, because of academic achievement, character, service, or leadership, has a right to become a member of the National Honor Society. Such membership is regarded as an honor. The faculty council is entrusted with making selection decisions.

By November 1, all students who have applied will receive a letter mailed to their address indicating whether or not they have been selected for NHS. The names of the new members will be announced by the present members at an assembly program. Once selected, members have the responsibility to continue to demonstrate the qualities of scholarship, leadership, service, and character. They are subject to re-evaluation each year.

Members who fall below the standards which were the basis for their selection will be promptly warned in writing by the chapter advisor and given a reasonable amount of time to correct the deficiency. Failure to correct the deficiency might warrant dismissal, except that in the case of flagrant violation of school rules or civic laws a member does not necessarily have to be warned. In all cases of impending dismissal, a member shall have a right to a hearing before the NHS Faculty Council.

Members of the National Honor Society will be expected to help the local chapter perform some service projects each year.
