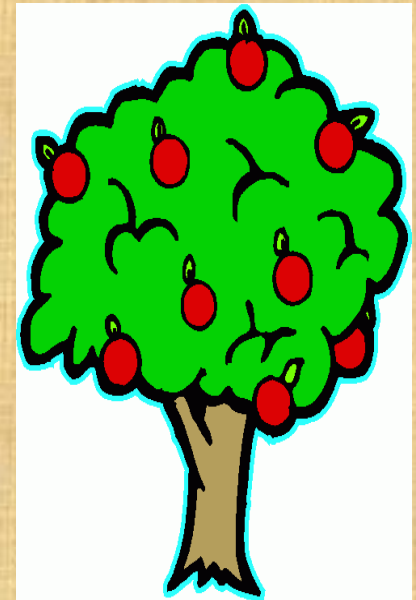
THE GIVING TREE

PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCES

Information on Title 1

Title I is a federally funded supplemental program that Central Lyon offers to help children gain the

confidence they need to help them succeed in the classroom. It serves as an early intervention program hoping that our numbers will decrease in the upper grades.

Students will be identified in the fall based on a teacher's checklist of alphabet letters and Sounds, as well as with the FAST testing. After test scores are compiled, classroom teachers and Title I teachers conference to discuss results. Teacher recommendation based on documentation and observation, help us determine which eligible students will receive Title I services. If your child is identified for reading help, you will be notified at the fall conference in November by the classroom teacher.

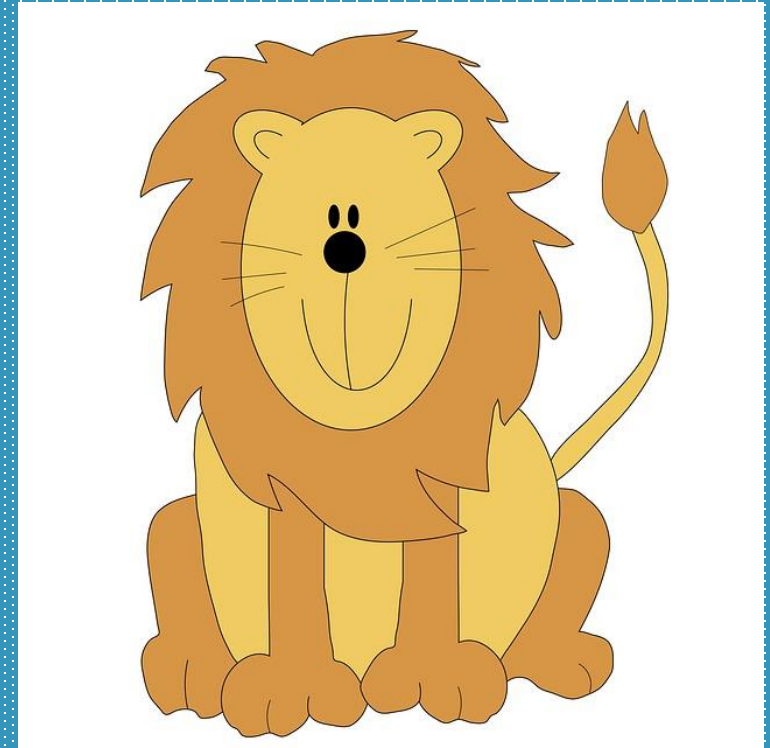
