## Persuasive Speech

## Requirements:

- → 5:00-7:00 in length (grade will be greatly affected if time not reached; score will drop one whole grade)
- → Typed Outline (this needs to be a correct outline--not a word-forword description of your speech)
- → Typed Bibliography (you must include at least *five* sources in your bibliography; two sources must be a non-internet source; you must have correct MLA bibliography format)
- → You need to cite at least *one* source within your speech
- → You need not only present a problem/argument and provide sufficient support, you need to move the audience to action and provide ways to solve this problem. (Give them some action to take.)

## Reminders:

- > There will be a question/answer period at the end of your speech. Be prepared to answer questions well because it will part of your grade.
- > Visual aid not required, but there is up to 3 possible extra credit points if you choose to use one (done well).
- No outline or example to follow this time around. See what you can do; you are a seasoned speech maker by now. ©
