- Add hyperlinks, graphics, tables, and color to a web page
- Organize electronic folders for saving images & updated web pages
- Update links on CL web page
- Use Internet to enhance web pages
- Optimize images using Paint Shop Pro
- Interpret basic HTML Code
- Meet deadlines and organize time

Paint Shop Pro7 & Digital Images - Weeks 1 & 2

Edit digital images and optimize them for use on web pages. Learn how to resize, crop, feather, and colorize images.

- Click the Paint Shop Pro7 link to get step-by-step instructions on how to use this photo-editing software. EVERY digital image must be edited in PSP7 before used on a web page.
- Complete the "Digital Image Assignment" where you will take pictures and edit them for use on a NEW student life page.
- You are required to demonstrate your knowledge of our digital equipment and software. This will be taught in small groups and you will take a quiz to measure your understanding.

Central Lyon Web Page - Week 3 to end of semester

- You can either volunteer for or will be assigned CL links to update. Check the assignment board.
- Everyone will create several student life pages.
- Each Monday, pick up a blue weekly report; it is due each Friday indicating what you worked on during the week and pages.
- We will also learn FrontPage and html during these weeks.

GUIDELINES:

- UPDATE current pages first—team picture and schedule; follow with pictures; year-end team stats only. Y
- Eliminate links that cannot be easily updated.
- Keep pages simple (free from too many animated images) so they load quickly & look clean. Do not spend too much time on one link.
- Copy entire folder to "Webber Update" folder on the f drive for uploading.
- Digital images may be available from the journalism staff.
- Headlines should be interesting and informative; not repeating the section name.
- Keep track of work done on blue weekly report.
