

Percussion Equipment

New this year, I will be requiring all percussion students to purchase a few pairs of mallets of their own and a stick bag to carry them in. Unfortunately, in the past, with so many percussion students using the school's mallets and sticks, they wear out VERY quickly and it has been difficult to keep quality mallets/sticks in our band room. Most schools require their percussion students to buy their own equipment as a way for them to be accountable and responsible. The financial commitment is still much less than a wind instrument. These stick/mallets that your students will purchase should last most of their band careers, if they take care of them.

If you own any of the below equipment, please have your student start bringing it back and forth to school – which is why the stick bag is a great idea – it's like a “case” for their instrument.
