Uses of the Human Skeleton

1. Protects organs
2. Movement on land (supports weight of body)
3. Produces Red Blood Cells and Stores Fats
4. Gives us our shape

Types of Joints

1. Pivot Joint- one bone rotates on another (Neck)
2. Hinge Joint- one that moves forward and backward (knee)
3. Ball & Socket- allows for circular motion (hip or shoulder)
4. Gliding Joint- allows bones to glide over another (ankle)

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
