Dear Friends of the Foundation,

Since the first Fund Raising Campaign in 2001, supporters of the Foundation have contributed over \$378,000. Approximately \$166,000 of these funds have been given to the Central Lyon school district to assist with current needs, including CLSF Lion Grants.
