1. **Complete this form** by typing or neatly handwriting your responses in the spaces provided below.
2. **Answer the nine (9) application questions** on separate pages.
 - Your responses must not exceed **four (4) single-sided, single-spaced pages**, using a **minimum 12-point Times New Roman font** and **1-inch margins**.
3. **Attach an official school transcript** that includes your attendance record, GPA, and current class rank.
 - If your school does not provide this information, please have a school official include a note on school letterhead stating that the information is unavailable.
4. **Attach your ACT, SAT, or other standardized test scores.**
5. **Include one (1) letter of recommendation** from a teacher, school official, or employer.
 - Please do not submit more than one letter.
6. **Submit your completed application** and all required attachments to the **Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD)** office in the county where you reside **no later than Friday, February 6, 2026**.
