It is proposed that Mr. Harman be reassigned to be the Principal of PK-4 grade and the District would hire an individual as 5-8 grade Principal along with the Activities Director duties/responsibilities. Mr. Ackerman would continue as High School Principal and Superintendent.

It is recommended to reassign Mr. Harman to PK-4 Principal and advertise the position of 5-8 Principal with Activities Director responsibilities.

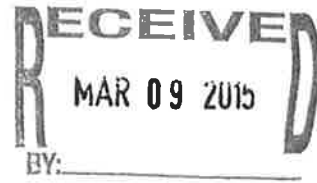
