Due to retirements and resignations we have several positions open within the district.

Jill Christensen has been employed a FACS teacher in a neighboring district. She is also interested in the extra-curricular positions of Co-Prom Advisor and NHS Advisor. Due to limited course enrollment, it is recommended to hire Mrs. Jill Christensen as the FACS teacher at .625 FTE, Co-Prom Advisor and NHS Advisor with potential increased FTE depending on course enrollment.

Two individuals were interviewed for the Social Studies/World History and TAG openings. Bradley Raveling is a recent graduate of Buena Vista University and we believe will be a good fit for our district. Mr. Raveling is also interested in being an advisor for the Mock Trial position. It is recommended to hire Mr. Bradley Raveling as the Social Studies/World History and TAG Teacher along with Mock Trial Advisor.

Two individuals were interviewed for the Food Service Supervisor position. Darsha Tuenge has a bachelors degree in business and has an extensive background in the food service industry. She is currently employed as a paraprofessional at Central Lyon. It is recommended to hire Mrs. Darsha Tuenge as the Food Service Director.

This past week Curtis Eben was interviewed by Elementary Principal, Steve Harman, George-Little Rock Activities Director, Tyler Glanzer, and Central Lyon Middle School Principal/Activities Director, Jason Engleman for the vacant Head Football Coaching Position. The interview team felt that Coach Eben had the knowledge and characteristics necessary to take over a traditional program such as the one developed at Central Lyon/George Little-Rock. Coach Eben currently manages a successful shared wrestling program between the two districts that the interview team feels he can carry over into football. Curtis has many years of experience in the Central Lyon/George-Little Rock football program both as a player and coach, making the transition much more effective.

Others were considered, but not interviewed for the position, as the interview team felt Coach Eben was best suited for the position. It is my recommendation to approve Coach Eben as the Head Football Coach for the vacant Head Football Coaching Position.
