

Uses of the Human Skeleton

- 1. Protects organs
- Movement on land (supports weight of body)
 Produces Red Blood Cells and Stores Fats
- 4. Gives us our shape

Types of Joints

- 1. Pivot Joint- one bone rotates on another (Neck)
- 2. Hinge Joint- one that moves forward and backward (knee)
- 3. Ball & Socket- allows for circular motion (hip or shoulder)
- 4. Gliding Joint- allows bones to glide over another (ankle)
