

REMINDERS for Solo/Ensemble Day:

Saturday, April 23rd

- ♪ Know your performance time(s) and performance room. Tell your accompanist!
- ♪ **Dress up for your performance!** You are a professional musician!
- ♪ Arrive 30min. early to get ready, warm-up, and tune.
- ♪ Use the elementary recess doors when you come to school.
- ♪ Use the Music Room, Title Reading Room, & Mrs. Weiler's Room to get your instrument ready and warm-up. Leave all cases, coats, etc. in the warm-up rooms!
- ♪ **DO NOT play in the hallway!**
- ♪ **DO NOT enter a performance room when someone is performing!**
- ♪ Go to your performance room a few minutes early so you won't be late, and wait quietly for your turn in the hallway.
- ♪ Reed players – remember to wet your reed – don't let it dry out!
- ♪ Brass players – remember to empty your spit!
- ♪ Snare Drum players – remember to turn the snare on!
- ♪ Remember to adjust your music stand to your height and wait to introduce your piece when the judge is ready.
- ♪ **Say your full name, title of your piece, and the composer.**
- ♪ **Smile! Have Fun! Do your best!**
- ♪ Listen to the judge afterwards and make sure to thank the judge!

Turn Over-----}

♪ **Thank your accompanist!** You can give them a card, a small gift, money, etc.
- whatever you are comfortable with. Remember, they put in time to help you
succeed!

♪ After your performance(s), you may leave and take your instrument home, or
you may wait to pick up your ribbon.

♪ Ribbons will be at Mr. Langholdt's table. It will take 25-30min. to get the
ribbons ready after you perform. You can listen to others perform while you wait!

♪ Take your instrument home because you will not be able to get into the band
room to leave it. Students will be performing in there.

♪ Be PROUD of yourself and your performance! No matter the color of your
ribbon or your rating from one single judge, I am PROUD of YOU!
