The mission of the Central Lyon School Foundation, Inc. is to enhance quality education through educational opportunities, school facilities, technology, and service.

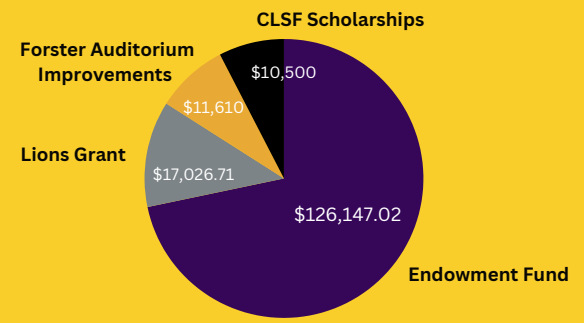
